Since serving displaced persons following World War II, LSS/NCA has partnered with local organizations, companies, and individual volunteers to aid in the resettlement of thousands of federally approved refugees as they begin new lives in the Washington DC Metro Area.

On the path to regain independence, families receive intensive case management, cultural orientation from our trained staff of professionals, and connections to local partner employers and landlords. We direct newcomers to appropriate community resources while helping them to become active members of their new communities. In return, refugees enrich our neighborhoods with their skills, diversity, and courage.
