LUTHERAN SOCIAL SERVICES OF THE NATIONAL CAPITAL AREA INAUGURATES TWO NEW SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS TO MARK 100 YEARS OF SERVING BOLDLY

More Than \$13,000 in Educational & Vocational Scholarships Now Available to Youth and Adults Served by LSS/NCA and its Partner Ministries

June 23, 2017 (Washington DC): In celebration of 100 years of SERVING BOLDLY, Lutheran Social Services of the National Capital Area today announced two new scholarship programs for the 2017-2018 school year, totaling \$13,500. The new BOLD JOURNEY and Elizaneth Krieser Weisburger Scholarships will be awarded annually to support post-secondary or vocational education for area youth and adults served by LSS/NCA and its partner ministries throughout the national capital area.

For 100 years, LSS/NCA has served the most vulnerable children in our community, envisioning wholeness and justice for all. In that vision, the new BOLD JOURNEY scholarships are intended to further the dreams and success of youth and adults by awarding up to \$10,000 per year to at least one LSS/NCA program participant to further their education in undergraduate or graduate institutions, or assist individuals in obtaining vocational training. The awardee will be a youth who is aging out of foster care, an unaccompanied refugee minor, a participant in a LSS/NCA's Youth Haven program, or an adult refugee.

The Elizabeth Kreiser Weisburger Scholarship will award \$3,500 to an individual who is recommended by a Lutheran Social Services ministry of the national capital area. The ministries include Community Family Life Services, Fellowship Square Foundation, Good Shepherd Housing Foundation, Lutheran Social Services of the National Capital Area, N Street Village, National Lutheran Communities and Services, Northern Virginia Coalition (NOVACO), Southeast Ministry, and Housing Up.
